Next Program: John Sherer—in Recital Sunday, February 12, 2017 at 4:00



Dayton. The program will be hosted by Jerry Taylor and John Neely. A native of Xenia, Dr. Sherer is one of the nation's preeminent organists and the Director of Music at the Fourth Presbyterian Church of Chicago, named by USA Today as one of the top ten places in America to be "enthralled by heavenly music". The church was featured, along with Dr. Sherer and the Morning Choir, in the motion picture "My Best Friend's Wedding". Reviewers have praised him for his "great creativity and élan" and described "his remarkable virtuoso technique and sensitive musical sense to serve the requirements of the music." Dr. Sherer has performed numerous recitals throughout the United States, abroad and for regional and national organist conventions. Sherer holds music and art degrees from the University of Cincinnati, Yale and Juilliard.

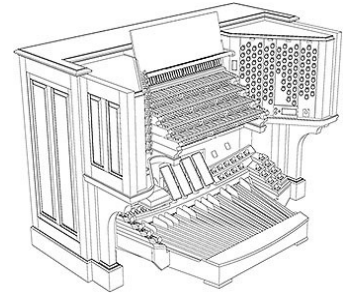
