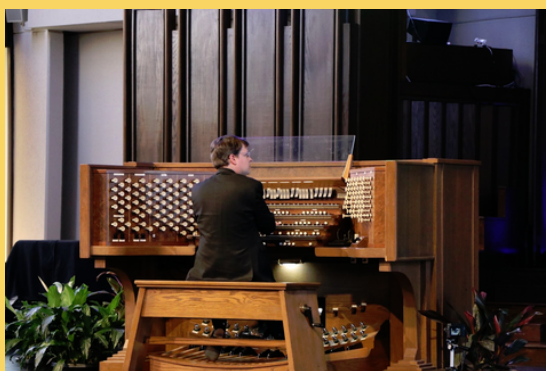

Although he lived only thirty-three years, Dunbar's contributions in poetry and prose left a legacy that endures today. On May 22, the Bach Society of Dayton celebrates Dunbar with choral and solo settings of his acclaimed poetry. The concert highlights three world premieres of new choral works by famed composer Adolphus Hailstork and the two winners of the Bach Society's Young Composers Competition.
